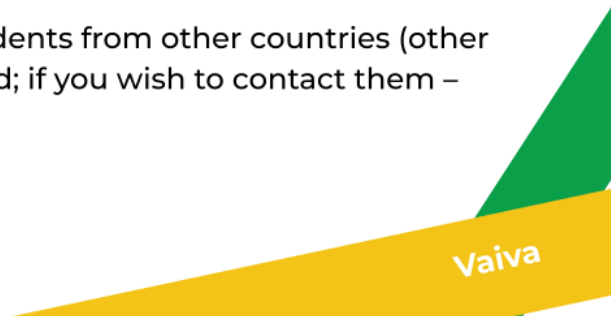

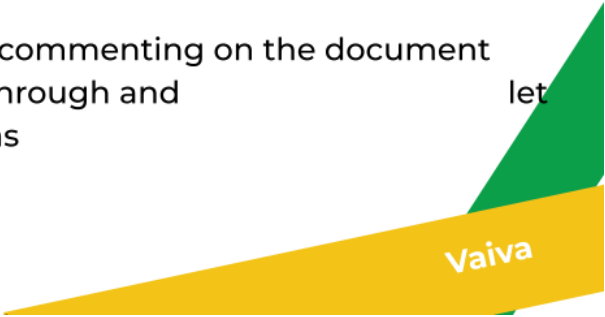

10. Confirmation of contest rules and procedures

Contest rules and procedures

Clarification of the rules

- CMS grading system this year
- The tasks will be sorted by difficulty (in increasing order). Note that contestants might disagree with the order, and there may still be easy subtasks for harder problems, so it is important that they read all problems
- Supported languages: C++ and Python3
- Note: scoring is done with subtask stitching (i.e., max for each subtask across all submissions)
- Full list is on the website: <https://egoi2026.it/competition/rules/>

Charlotte

We are using CMS for grading (this is new)

Please make sure your contestants know how to use this

Also remind them of the sub-tasks and subtask stitching

It can be useful to go to the next task when stuck

Information for the practice session

- **Bring – and leave – keyboards and items to the practice session!!**
- Remind your contestants to familiarize themselves with CMS
- Test asking for clarifications. This is the preferred way to ask about technical issues if at all possible.
- Any requests to TC members must be **submitted during the practice.**
- Tell your contestants to **test their preferred editors.**
